## WHAT DOES University Islamic Financial Corporation DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Social Security number and income</li> <li>■ credit history and payment history</li> <li>■ account transactions and credit scores</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share <b>customers'</b> personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their <b>customers'</b> personal information; the reasons University Islamic Financial Corporation chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>For our everyday business purposes—</b> such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

## What we do

How does **University Islamic Financial Corporation** protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Furthermore, annual information security training is provided to all employees.

How does **University Islamic Financial Corporation** collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- pay your bills or apply for financing
- apply for a lease or provide employment information
- give us your wage statements

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

## Definitions

**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *University Islamic Financial Corporation does not share with our affiliates*

**Nonaffiliates**

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *University Islamic Financial Corporation does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you*

**Joint marketing**

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *University Islamic Financial Corporation doesn't jointly market*

## Other important information
